Obituary for Brice Franklin Scalley

Age 79 of West Palm Beach, Florida, answered his final muster on January 23, 2017. Born in Ohio on October 30, 1937, Brice moved to Florida. Brice graduated from Lake Worth High School in 1958. Brice was Commander of Camp 3, Department of Florida, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War and Sons of Veterans Reserve. He loved military history and American patriotism. Brice was a member of many historical, veterans, and alumni organizations. A memorial service, with military honors, was held at All County Funeral Home, Del Lago Chapel, 131 South Lakeside Drive, Lake Worth, FL 33460, on Wednesday, February 1, 2017, at 1900 hours. Viewing, with an honor guard, took place from 1800 to 2000 hours.
